ROAD TRAFFIC

The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 28 Swavesey/Boxworth, Cambridgeshire) Westbound Entry and Exit Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 31st January 2011

Coming into force - - 7th February 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road ("the A14") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon and nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 28, Swavesey/Boxworth, Cambridgeshire) Westbound Entry and Exit Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th February 2011.
 - 2. In this Order
 - "works" mean local authority carriageway resurfacing works;
 - "a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 14 February 2011 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;
 - "a slip road" means the A14 Junction 28 westbound –
 - (a) exit slip road from its junction with the A14 to a point 30 metres east of its junction with the Swavesey/Boxworth Roundabout (near Shell Service Area), and
 - (b) entry slip road from a point 30 metres west of its junction with the Swavesey/Boxworth Roundabout (near Shell Service Area) to its junction with the A14;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works.
