## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M1 Motorway (Junctions 20 to 21) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 7th November 2011

Coming into force - - 14th November 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and on two of those connecting roads, in the County of Leicestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 20 to 21) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 14th November 2011.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the motorway"

(i) the northbound carriageway of the M1 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 20 to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 21; and

means -

(ii) the southbound carriageway of the M1 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 21 to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 20;

"a slip road" means the slip road leading –

(i) to the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 20; and

(ii) to the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 21:

"the works period" means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 21st

November 2011 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway or a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
  - (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
