**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M6 Motorway (Junction 19, Northbound and Southbound  
Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)  
Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *6th December 2011*

*Coming into force* - - *11th December 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those slip roads in Cheshire East should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a) hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 19, Northbound and Southbound Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 11th December 2011.

**2.** In this Order;

“motorway” means the M6 Motorway;

“works” means road marking, resurfacing and maintenance works on the slip roads;

“the first slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 19;

“the second slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 19;

“the third slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 19;

“the fourth slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 19;

“the works period” means eight nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 12 December 2011 and ending on Tuesday 31 January 2012. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first, second, third or fourth slip roads.
4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
