ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Towcester, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 3 January 2011

Coming into force - - 10 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Towcester in the County of Northamptonshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Towcester, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 10 January 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A5 between a point 110 metres north and a

point 125 metres south of the centre point of its junction with Brackley Road/Northampton Road at Towcester;

"the verge" means any part of the trunk road which is not a

carriageway;

"the works period" means the period starting at 18.00 hours on Saturday 15

January 2011 and ending when the said works have been

completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the verge adjacent to the trunk road.

- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
