## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A259 Trunk Road (Winchelsea - Rye) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2011

Made - - - 12th December 2011

Coming into force - - 31st December 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Winchelsea - Rye) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31st December 2011.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A259 Trunk Road in the County of East Sussex;

"the first length of trunk road" means both carriageways of the trunk road (Royal Military Road) between points 80 metres north of Strand Bridge and 1730 metres north of that bridge;

"the second length of trunk road" means both carriageways of the trunk road (Tanyard Lane/Royal Military Road) between points 641 metres west of Strand Bridge and 1780 metres north of that bridge;

"works" mean carriageway repairs and all associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 2000 hours on Tuesday 3rd January 2012 or on any subsequent day until 30th June 2013.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding
  - (a) 10 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length of road are displayed; or
  - (b) 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.

<b>4.</b> The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011( <b>a</b> ) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
