ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A46 Trunk Road (Evesham, Worcestershire) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *14th November 2011*
Coming into force - - *21st November 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Evesham in the County of Worcestershire should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A46 Trunk Road (Evesham, Worcestershire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 21st November 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 between its roundabout junction with the A4035 Badsey Road and its roundabout junction with the A4184 (Twyford Roundabout);

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the period starting at 16.00 hours on Thursday 24th November 2011 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order, cause or permit any vehicle –

- (i) to drive at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road; or
- (ii) overtake a moving vehicle in the trunk road.

5. The provisions of –

(a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle-

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and

(b) article 3 (i) shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes.
