ROAD TRAFFIC

The A419 Trunk Road (Kingshill and Lower Widhill Farm Junctions, Near Cricklade, Wiltshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 21st December 2011

Coming into force - - 31st December 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A419 Trunk Road ("the A419"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Cricklade in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A419 Trunk Road (Kingshill and Lower Widhill Farm Junctions, Near Cricklade, Wiltshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31st December 2011.

2. In this Order –

"the A419" means the A419 between the Cricklade Junction and the Lady Lane Junction, near Swindon;

"central reservation" means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road;

"the works" mean the installation of hazard marker posts;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 3rd January 2012 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through a gap in the central reservation opposite the junctions of the A419 with Lower Widhill Farm and Kingshill Farm Recycling Centre.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b)	a vehicle being used at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable or traffic
	officer in uniform;
(c)	a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
