ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Plympton to Ivybridge) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and some of those connecting roads between Plympton and Ivybridge in the District of South Hams in the County of Devon, should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Plympton to Ivybridge) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th January 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the first length of the A38" means the eastbound carriageway of the A38 from a point 3950 metres west of the centre of the Voss Farm Overbridge to a point 3900 metres east of the centre of that overbridge;

"the second length of the A38" means the eastbound carriageway of the A38 from a point 700 metres west of the centre of the Voss Farm Overbridge to a point 3900 metres east of the centre of that overbridge;

"the slip roads" mean (i) the eastbound entry slip road at the A38 Deep Lane Junction; and (ii) the eastbound entry slip road at the A38 Lee Mill Junction;

"the slip road" means the eastbound entry slip road at the A38 Lee Mill Junction;

"layby" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**); and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"the works" mean resurfacing and other maintenance works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 9th January 2012 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4, 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period:

- (a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of the A38 and the slip roads;
- (b) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the second length of the A38 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that road are displayed;
- (c) cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the laybys adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the A38 situated:
 - (i) 1000 metres west of the centre of the Voss Farm Overbridge;
 - (ii) 1100 metres east of the centre of the Voss Farm Overbridge;
 - (iii) 2000 metres east of the centre of the Voss Farm Overbridge;
- (d) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

5. The provisions of articles 3(c) and (d) shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
