ROAD TRAFFIC

The M18 Motorway and the M62 Motorway (Langham Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 2nd February 2011

Coming into force - - 7th February 2011

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M18 Motorway, the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the East Riding of Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads should be prohibited because varioguard removal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M18 Motorway and the M62 Motorway (Langham Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 7th February 2011.
- **2.** In this Order "the link road" means the link road connecting the M18 Motorway northbound carriageway with the M62 Motorway eastbound carriageway at Langham Interchange (the M62 Motorway Junction 35 and M18 Motorway Junction 7).
- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 7 hours starting at 23:00 hours on Tuesday 8 February 2011 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
