**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A5 Trunk Road (Church Street to Queensway, High Street North, Dunstable) Northbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - 4 January 2011

*Coming into force* - - 11 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on that road in the County of Bedfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Church Street to Queensway, High Street North, Dunstable) Northbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 11 January 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 17 January 2011 or on any subsequent day until works to install traffic detector loops in the surface of the carriageway have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound carriageway of A5 between the centre lines of its junctions with Church Street and Queensway.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, or winter service maintenance purposes.
