## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A1 Trunk Road (Stamford to Blyth) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Laybys) Order 2011

Made - - - - 4th February 2011

Coming into force - - 11th February2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road ("the A1"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Stamford and Blyth in the District of the County of Rutland and the Counties of Lincolnshire and Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Stamford to Blyth) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Laybys) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 11th February 2011.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A1 from the centreline of the A606 overbridge

near Stamford to the centreline of the A614 overbridge at

Blyth:

"layby" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of

vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and

which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 14

February 2011 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway or the southbound carriageway of the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
    - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
    - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
    - (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
