## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A36 Trunk Road (Steeple Langford, Wiltshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 8th February 2011

Coming into force - - 12th February 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Steeple Langford in Wiltshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Steeple Langford, Wiltshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12th February 2011.
  - 2. In this Order -

"the A36" means the A36 between its junctions with Salisbury Road either side of Steeple Langford;

"the works" mean resurfacing;

"a works period" means a period of 11 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 14th February 2011 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the A36.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the A36 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that road are displayed.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; or
  - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
