ROAD TRAFFIC

The A36 Trunk Road (Whaddon, near Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Whaddon, Salisbury, in Wiltshire should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Whaddon, near Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 19th February 2011.

2. In this Order:

"layby" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**); and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"the A36" means the A36 southbound, south of Whaddon, from a point 600 metres north of its junction with Windwhistle Lane to a point 1200 metres south of that junction;

"the works" mean BT cabling works;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 21st February 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period:

- (a) cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the layby adjacent to the A36 southbound, situated immediately north of Windwhistle Lane;
- (b) cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle in the A36.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.
