## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M271 Motorway (M27 Junction 3 – Romsey Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 21st February 2011

 Coming into force
 12th March 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M271 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M271 Motorway (M27 Junction 3 – Romsey Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12th March 2011.

## 2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M271 Motorway in the County of Hampshire;

"the northbound carriageway" means the northbound carriageway of the motorway between the roundabout at its junction with the M27 at Junction 3 and Romsey Road roundabout (A3057);

"the southbound carriageway" means the southbound carriageway of the motorway between Romsey Road roundabout (A3057) and the roundabout at its junction with the M27 at Junction 3;

"works" mean essential carriageway repairs and all associated work on the motorway; and

"a works period" means a period of 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 14th March 2011 or on any subsequent day until 11th September 2012.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound carriageway or the southbound carriageway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
