ROAD TRAFFIC

The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 15 Bythorn, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made--21st February 2011Coming into force-28th February 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road ("the A14") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 15 Bythorn, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 28th February 2011.

2. In this Order –

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**); and in this definition "carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"works" mean the construction of hard-standings and footway for safe access to feeder pillars, drainage works, grass cutting, weed spraying and sweeping;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 7th March 2011 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the lay-by adjacent to the westbound carriageway of the A14 situated 1000 metres east of the centre line of its junction with the B663 Toll Bar Lane, Keyston, during the works period.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works or for winter service maintenance, or
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes,
