## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M42 Motorway (Junction 5) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 18th February 2011

 Coming into force
 25th February 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway ("the M42") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M42 Motorway (Junction 5) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 25th February 2011.

2. In this Order –

"a slip road" means any slip road leading to or from the M42 at

Junction 5;

"the works period" means the period starting at 09.00 hours on Tuesday 1st

March 2011 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in a slip road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- **6.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle
  - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
  - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 4 shall apply to any vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
