ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A38 Trunk Road (Coxbench to Little Eaton, Derbyshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *21st February 2011*

Coming into force - - *28th February 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads between Coxbench and Little Eaton in the County of Derbyshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Coxbench to Little Eaton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 28th February 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with slip road leading to the B6179, Derby Road (Coxbench Interchange) to its roundabout junction with the A61, Alfreton Road (south of Little Eaton);

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A38 from the B6179, Derby Road (Coxbench Interchange);

“the works period” means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 7th March 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
