ROAD TRAFFIC

The A45 Trunk Road (near Wellingborough, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road ("the A45") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads near Wellingborough in the County of Northamptonshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (near Wellingborough, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 4th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road"	means the westbound carriageway of the A45 from its junction with slip road leading to the roundabout junction with the A509/B573 (Denington Industrial Estate) to its roundabout junction with the A509 (Wilby Way Roundabout);		
"a slip road"	means the slip road leading to –		
	 i) the westbound carriageway of the A45 from its roundabout junction with the A509/B573 (Denington Industrial Estate); and ii) the westbound carriageway of the A45 from its junction with the B573, Doddington Road/Millers Park; 		
"the works period"	means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 8th March 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
