ROAD TRAFFIC

The A55 Trunk Road Junction 36 (to be re-numbered Junction 37) Connecting Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A55 Trunk Road and its connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads in Cheshire West and Chester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A55 Trunk Road Junction 36 (to be re-numbered Junction 37) Connecting Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 27th February 2011.

2. In this Order;

"the trunk road" means the A55 Trunk Road;

"works" means resurfacing, road marking and loop cutting works on the trunk road and connecting roads;

"the works period" means a period over seven nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 28 February 2011 and ending on Friday 1 April 2011. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the first slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at Junction 36;

"the second slip road" means the exit slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road at Junction 36;

"the third slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the trunk road at Junction 36;

"the dedicated lane" means the dedicated left turn lane leading to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at Junction 36 from the A483 southbound.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first, second or third slip roads, or the dedicated lane.
- 4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the said works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
