The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 8, Stevenage, Hertfordshire) Northbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 17 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway ("the A1(M)") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 8, Stevenage, Hertfordshire) Northbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 17 January 2011.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 8 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 24 January 2011, or on any subsequent day until works to replace road studs and realign hazard marker posts have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound entry slip road of the A1(M) leading from the A1(M)/A602 Interchange at Junction 8.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter service maintenance purposes.
