ROAD TRAFFIC

The A36 Trunk Road (Wilton, Near Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2011

 Made
 11 January 2011

 Coming into force
 15 January 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Wilton, Salisbury, in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Wilton, Near Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 15 January 2011.

2. In this Order -

"the A36" means the footpath adjacent to the northern side of the A36 near Wilton, Salisbury, from the eastern edge of Wilton Roundabout to its junction with Netherhampton Road;

"the works" mean footway resurfacing and widening works;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 17 January 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no pedestrian shall, during the works period, enter or proceed in the A36.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) construction and emergency services personnel;
 - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
 - (c) pedestrians proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from the A36.
