ROAD TRAFFIC

The A500 Trunk Road (Etruria, Stoke-on-Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road ("the A500") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and one of those connecting roads at Etruria in the City of Stoke-on-Trent should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A500 Trunk Road (Etruria, Stoke-on-Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 14th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road"	means the northbound carriageway of the A500 from its junction with the A50 to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A53 (Etruria Roundabout);
"the slip road"	means the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A500 to its roundabout junction with the A53 (Etruria Roundabout);
"the works period"	means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 21st March 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
