ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Harcombe, Near Exeter) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and one of those connecting roads near Harcombe in the District of Teignbridge in the County of Devon should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Harcombe, Near Exeter) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 19th February 2011.

2. In this Order –

"the first length of the A38" means the southbound carriageway of the A38 from a point at the centre of the A380 Overbridge to a point adjacent to the entrance to Exeter Racecourse;

"the second length of the A38" means the southbound carriageway of the A38 from a point adjacent to the entrance to Exeter Racecourse to a point at the centre of Milestone Overbridge;

"the slip road" means the southbound exit slip road at the B3344 Junction (north of Milestone Overbridge);

"the works" mean the installation of a CCTV camera system, ducting and barrier works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 21st February 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 21st February 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period:

(a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 60 miles per hour on the first length of the A38;

- (b) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the second length of the A38;
- (c) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; or
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

6. The provisions of article 3(c) shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.
