ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A45 Trunk Road (near Bickenhill, Solihull) (Slip Roads)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *7th March 2011*
Coming into force - - *14th March 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (near Bickenhill, Solihull) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 14th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the slip road” means the slip road leading –

- a) to the eastbound carriageway of the A45 from its roundabout junction with South Way and the slip roads leading to and from the M42 (Junction 6), from its junction with Middle Bickenhill Lane;
- b) to the westbound carriageway of the A45 from its roundabout junction with the A452, known as Stonebridge Roundabout, from its junction with the service road (Coventry Road);

“the works period” means the period starting at 21:30 hours on Monday 21st March 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or

(c) being used in connection with the said works.
