ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Linhay Junction, Ashburton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Ashburton in the District of Teignbridge in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Linhay Junction, Ashburton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 15 January 2011.

2. In this Order –

"the A38" means the eastbound carriageway of the A38 at the Linhay Junction, Ashburton, from the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at that junction to the tip of the nosing of the eastbound entry slip road at that junction;

"the tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean resurfacing and associated works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 17 January 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A38.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works, for traffic officer purposes or for winter maintenance purposes.
