The M6 Motorway (Junctions 39 - 38, Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 10th March 2011

 Coming into force
 13th March 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway is satisfied that traffic on that motorway, in the District of Eden, in the County of Cumbria should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junctions 39 38, Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 13th March 2011.
- **2.** In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M6 Motorway;

"the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road" means the last point where the slip road leaves the carriageway of the motorway;

"the length of carriageway" means a section of the southbound carriageway of the motorway from a point 4 kilometres south of the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 39 to a point 5 kilometres south of the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 39.

"works" means safety barrier works on the motorway;

"the works period" means a period starting at 0600 hours on Monday 14 March 2011 and ending at 0600 hours on Saturday 18 March 2011. However, work may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the length of carriageway.
