ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway and the A414 Trunk Road (Junction 8 Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire) Connecting Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 14th March 2011

 Coming into force
 21st March 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1"), the A414 Trunk Road ("the A414") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and on some of those connecting roads in the District of St Albans in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway and the A414 Trunk Road (Junction 8 Hemel Hempstead, Hertfordshire) Connecting Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 21st March 2011.
 - 2. In this Order -

"works" mean Local Authority roundabout improvement and re-surfacing works to the A414 Breakspear Way/Green Lane Roundabout;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Thursday 31st March 2011 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the
 - (a) A414 northbound carriageway from its junction with the A5183 Park Street Roundabout St Albans to, and including, the northbound exit slip road at M1 Junction 8 Hemel Hempstead,
 - (b) M1 northbound entry and southbound exit slip roads at Junction 8, or
 - (c) A414 southbound entry slip road leading from Hemel Hempstead.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or

winter service maintenance purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
