ROAD TRAFFIC

The A419 Trunk Road (White Hart Junction, Swindon) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011

Made		-	-	15th March 2011
Coming in	to force	-	-	19th March 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A419 Trunk Road ("the A419") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and some of those connecting roads in the Borough of Swindon should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A419 Trunk Road (White Hart Junction, Swindon) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 19th March 2011.

2. In this Order –

"the A419" means (i) the southbound carriageway of the A419 in Swindon from a point 140 metres southeast of the tip of the nosing of the southbound exit slip road at the A361 Honda Junction to a point 200 metres southeast of the tip of the nosing of the southbound exit slip road at the A420 White Hart Junction; and (ii) the northbound carriageway of the A419 in Swindon from a point 200 metres southeast of the centre of the Wanborough Road Underbridge to a point 175 metres northwest of the centre of the Stratton Road Railway Overbridge;

"the slip roads" mean (i) the southbound entry slip road at the A361 Honda Junction; and (ii) the northbound exit slip road at the A420 White Hart Junction;

"the slip road" means the southbound exit slip road at the A420 White Hart Junction, Swindon;

"tip of the nosing" means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean works on the A419 Stratton Road Railway Bridge;

"a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 21st March 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the A419 and the slip roads.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

6. The provisions of article 4 shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works, for traffic officer purposes or leaving the Madison Hotel.
