ROAD TRAFFIC

The A45 and A46 Trunk Roads (Coventry Eastern Bypass) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road ("the A45") the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46") and connecting roads is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those trunk roads and one of those connecting roads, in the City of Coventry and in the County of Warwickshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 and A46 Trunk Roads (Coventry Eastern Bypass) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 18th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

"Festival Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A45/A46/A444 roundabout junction;
"Tollbar End Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A45/A46/B4110 roundabout junction;
"Binley Woods Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A45/A428 roundabout junction;
"the first length of trunk road"	means –
	(i) the northbound carriageway of the A45 between Tollbar End Roundabout and the slip road leading from Festival Roundabout; and

	(ii) the southbound carriageway of the A45 between the slip road leading to Festival Roundabout and Tollbar End Roundabout;
"the second length of trunk road"	means the westbound and eastbound carriageways of the A46 between Tollbar End Roundabout and Binley Woods Roundabout;
"the slip road"	means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A45 from Festival Roundabout;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 21st March 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on Tollbar End Roundabout, whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length of road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of trunk road, the second length of trunk road or the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of:

- (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- (b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
