ROAD TRAFFIC

The A40 Trunk Road (M5 Junction 11 to Elmbridge Court Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A40 Trunk Road ("the A40") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads at the M5 Junction 11 (Golden Valley) Interchange in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A40 Trunk Road (M5 Junction 11 to Elmbridge Court Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 26th March 2011.

2. In this Order –

"the A40" means the westbound carriageway of the A40 between the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the M5 Junction 11 (Golden Valley) Interchange and the eastern edge of the Elmbridge Court Roundabout;

"the slip road" means the A40 westbound entry slip road at the M5 Junction 11 (Golden Valley) Interchange;

"the works" mean resurfacing works;

"tip of the nosing" means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 28th March 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the A40 and the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the works.
