ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A663 Trunk Road (Broadway, Chadderton) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - - *28th March 2012*

Coming into force - - - - - *1st April 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A663 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road in the District of Oldham in Greater Manchester should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A663 Trunk Road (Broadway, Chadderton) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1st April 2012.
2. In this Order:

“the length of carriageway” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A663 Trunk Road from a point 10 metres south west of the centreline of the junction with Hunt Lane to a point 130 metres north east of the centreline of the junction with the B6189 Whitegate Lane;

“the works period” means a period starting at 0930 hours on Monday 2 April 2012 and ending at 1530 hours on Friday 31 August 2012. However, works may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“works” means junction construction and improvement works on the trunk road.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven in the length of carriageway at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.

5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
