## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A12 Trunk Road (Lowestoft, Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road ("the A12"), is satisfied that traffic on that road at Lowestoft in the County of Suffolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Lowestoft, Suffolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 16th January 2012.

2. In this Order –

"works" mean repair of collapsed sewer;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 23rd January 2012 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to leave the A12 Station Square at its junction with Waveney Road, Lowestoft.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for or in connection with the works, or for winter service maintenance,
- (b) being used for, police, fire and rescue authority ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a police constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
