## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A36 Trunk Road (Beckington to Warminster) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 12th January 2012

Coming into force - - 21st January 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Beckington and Warminster in the County of Somerset and in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Beckington to Warminster) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 21st January 2012.

## 2. In this Order –

"the A36" means the A36 from the southern edge of the A361 roundabout junction to Trowbridge, north of Beckington, to the northern edge of the A350 Bath Road Roundabout, north of Warminster;

"the works" mean highway maintenance, patching, white lining and stud replacement;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 23rd January 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the A36.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
