The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southend-on-Sea) (Amendment) Regulations 2012

Made--30th April 2012Coming into force-26th May 2012

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Southend-on-Sea, Essex, by reason of the intended holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place there on 26th and 27th May 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 161 of the Air Navigation Order $2009(\mathbf{a})$.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southend-on-Sea) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 26th May 2012.

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southend-on-Sea) Regulations 2012(**b**) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3(1), for "1100 hours and 1600 hours" substitute "1300 hours and 1700 hours".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Southend-on-Sea) Regulations 2012 (S.I. 2012/83) to make a change to the timing of the flying restrictions applicable on 26th and 27th May 2012 in relation to the Southend-on-Sea air show.

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
