The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Old Trafford, Manchester)
Regulations 2012

 Made
 14th May 2012

 Coming into force
 1st June 2012

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Old Trafford, Manchester, by reason of the intended holding of certain London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games' events that are scheduled to take place there between 26th July 2012 and 7th August 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Old Trafford, Manchester) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 1st June 2012.
 - **2.** In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.
- **3.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), no aircraft is to fly below 2,300 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 2 nautical miles whose centre is at 532747N 0021729W
 - (a) between 1400 hours and 2245 hours on 26th July 2012;
 - (b) between 0900 hours and 1745 hours on 29th July 2012;
 - (c) between 1415 hours and 2015 hours on 31st July 2012;
 - (d) between 1400 hours and 2000 hours on 1st August 2012;
 - (e) between 0900 hours and 1500 hours on 4th August 2012;
 - (f) between 1645 hours and 2245 hours on 6th August 2012; and
 - (g) between 1645 hours and 2245 hours on 7th August 2012.
 - (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying—
 - (a) in the service of, or with the permission of, the Chief Constable of Greater Manchester Police:
 - (b) in the service of the Helicopter Emergency Medical Service;

- (c) in accordance with an air traffic control clearance issued by the air traffic control unit at Manchester Airport provided the commander of the aircraft complies with any instructions from that unit;
- (d) with the permission of the air traffic control unit at City Airport (Manchester) for the purposes of taking off or landing at that airport provided the commander of the aircraft complies with any instructions from that unit; or
- (e) in the service of the Olympic Broadcasting Service.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

Between 26th July 2012 and 7th August 2012, Old Trafford, Manchester, will be the venue for certain London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games' events. For security and public safety reasons, the Chief Constable of Greater Manchester Police has requested the Secretary of State to make Restriction of Flying Regulations for the area in the vicinity of Old Trafford; this request has been endorsed by the Directorate of Airspace Policy.

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
