The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham-by-Sea) (Amendment) Regulations 2012

Made - - - - 10th May 2012

Coming into force - - 1st September 2012

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Shoreham-by-Sea, West Sussex, by reason of the intended holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place on 1st and 2nd September 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham-by-Sea) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 1st September 2012.
- **2.** The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham-by-Sea) Regulations 2012(**b**) are amended as follows.
 - 3. In regulation 3(1), for "1000 hours and 1600 hours" substitute "0800 hours and 1700 hours".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham–by-Sea) Regulations 2012 (S.I. 2012/871) ("the principal Regulations"). The effect of the amendment is to extend the times between which the flying restrictions are applicable under the principal Regulations in relation to the Shoreham-by-Sea air show on 1st and 2nd September 2012.

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
