The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Guildford) Regulations 2012

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Loseley Park, Guildford, Surrey, by reason of the intended holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place there on 23rd June 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order $2009(\mathbf{a})$.

Citation, commencement and revocation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Guildford) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 23rd June 2012.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), during the period between 1600 hours and 2000 hours on 23rd June 2012 no aircraft is to fly below 2,500 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 3 nautical miles whose centre is at 511311N 0003619W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying-

- (a) an instrument approach to Runway 24 or instrument departure from Runway 06 at Farnborough Airport in accordance with an air traffic control clearance issued by the air traffic control unit at that airport provided the commander of the aircraft complies with any instructions from that unit, or
- (b) with the permission of the Loseley Park flying display director.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Guildford, Surrey, on the occasion of an air show that will be held at Loseley Park. A number of civil and military aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the event. The Civil Aviation Authority's Safety Regulation Group and Directorate of Airspace Policy, with the agreement of the Department for Transport, consider that flying should be restricted during the air show in the vicinity of Guildford for reasons of public safety.

Full details of the airspace restrictions will be promulgated by NOTAM.
