## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M1 Motorway (Junctions 2 and 4, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 21st May 2012

 Coming into force
 9th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 2 and 4, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 9th June 2012.

## 2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M1 Motorway in the London Borough of Barnet;

"a slip road" means –

- (a) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway from the A41 (Edgware Way) at Junction 4,
- (b) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway to the A41 (Edgware Way) at Junction 4, or
- (c) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway from the A1 (Great North Way) at Junction 2;

"works" mean carriageway resurfacing work for Transport for London near the motorway; and

"a works period" means a period of 8½ hours starting at 2130 hours on Monday 11th June 2012 or on any subsequent day until 8th December 2013.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
