The A419 Trunk Road (Cirencester) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 22nd May 2012

 Coming into force
 26th May 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A419 Trunk Road ("the A419") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads near Circnester in the District of Cotswold in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A419 Trunk Road (Cirencester) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 26th May 2012.

2. In this Order -

"the A419" means (i) the northbound carriageway of the A419 near Cirencester between the tip of the nosing of the northbound exit slip road at the Driffield Junction and the tip of the nosing of the northbound entry slip road at the Burford Road Junction; or (ii) the southbound carriageway of the A419 near Cirencester between the tip of the nosing of the southbound exit slip road at the Burford Road Junction to the tip of the nosing of the southbound entry slip road at the Driffield Junction;

"the slip roads" mean the southbound entry slip road or the northbound exit slip road at the A419 Burford Road Junction, Cirencester:

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean surfacing and routine maintenance works including gully emptying, lining, studs, litter picking and grass cutting;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 28th May 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A419 and the slip roads.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
 - (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
