The A47 Trunk Road (Toftwood Interchange, Dereham, Norfolk) Westbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 28th May 2012

 Coming into force
 4th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road ("the A47") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Norfolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road (Toftwood Interchange, Dereham, Norfolk) Westbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 4th June 2012.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 11th June 2012, or on any subsequent day until local authority works to resurface the carriageway of the A1075 Yaxham Road Roundabout, Dereham have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the westbound exit or entry slip roads at the A47/A1075 Toftwood Interchange.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
