## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M4 Motorway (Junctions 15-16) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2012

 Made
 6th June 2012

 Coming into force
 9th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M4 Motorway ("the M4"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Junctions 15 and 16 in the Borough of Swindon should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M4 Motorway (Junctions 15-16) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 9th June 2012.

## 2. In this Order -

"the M4" means both carriageways of the M4 between Junctions 15 and 16 from a point at the centre of Broome Manor Lane Overbridge to a point 500 metres west of the centre of Mill Lane Overbridge;

"the hard shoulder" means the hard shoulder within the meaning of regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations which is adjacent to the M4;

"the Regulations" means the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(b);

"the works" mean repairing paint defects on Wichelstowe - Blackhorse Bridge;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 11th June 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the M4.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; or
  - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

- **5.** During a works period, regulation 5 and (insofar as it relates to a vehicle being driven) regulation 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended, in respect of the hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- **6**. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
