## ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junction 32 Southbound Link Road to the M55 Westbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 6th June 2012

 Coming into force
 13th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and its link roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those link roads in the District of Preston in the County of Lancashire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 32 Southbound Link Road to the M55 Westbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 13th June 2012.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M6 Motorway;

"works" means electrical loop replacement works on the motorway slip road;

"the works period" means one night between 2200 hours and 0530 hours starting on Thursday 14 June 2012 and ending on Friday 15 June 2012.

However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the link road" means the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway to the M55 Motorway westbound.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4.	The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent
	as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
	being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services,
	vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle
	proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in
	uniform.
