## ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junction 34, Northbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 7th June 2012

Coming into force - - 24th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Lancaster in the County of Lancashire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 34, Northbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 24th June 2012.

## 2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M6 Motorway;

"works" means electrical works on the motorway slip road;

"the works period" means three nights between 2100 hours and 0600 hours during a period starting on Monday 25 June 2012 and ending on Friday 29 June 2012.

However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 34.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4.	The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent
	as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
	being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services.
	vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle
	proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in
	uniform.
