The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stratford) (Revocation) Regulations 2012

Made - at 17.19 hours on 19th June 2012

Coming into force - - with immediate effect

The Secretary of State deemed it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Stratford, London, by reason of security and flight safety measures required in the vicinity of the Olympic Park due to activities that were scheduled to take place there between 19th June and 13th July 2012.

The Secretary of State no longer deems it necessary to restrict flying in the vicinity of Stratford and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stratford) (Revocation) Regulations 2012 and come into force with immediate effect.

Revocation

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stratford) Regulations 2012(b) are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations revoke the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Stratford) Regulations 2012 (S.I. 2012/1632), which imposed restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Stratford, London in the period between 19th June and 13th July 2012, as the Metropolitan Police Service which requested those restrictions no longer considers them to be required.
