ROAD TRAFFIC

The A66 Trunk Road (Naddle Beck Layby Closure) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A66 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on that road in the District of Allerdale in the County of Cumbria should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A66 Trunk Road (Naddle Beck Layby Closure) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 5th February 2012.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A66 Trunk Road;

"the layby to be closed" means the layby adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at a point 560 metres east of the centreline of Burns Farm Junction;

"the works period" means days between 0900 hours and 1600 hours during a period starting on Monday 6 February 2012 and ending on Friday 24 February 2012. Work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent days, or continue daily until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"works" means environmental improvement works;

"layby" means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (**b**);

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby to be closed.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
