## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A19 Trunk Road (Moor Farm Roundabout to Killingworth Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 5th July 2012

 Coming into force
 16th July 2012

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of North Tyneside and the County of Northumberland, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and one of those connecting roads should be prohibited because Variable Message Sign replacement works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Moor Farm Roundabout to Killingworth Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 16th July 2012.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Tuesday 17th July 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A19 Trunk Road:
  - southbound carriageway from its junction with the A189 Moor Farm Roundabout to the nose of the southbound entry slip road at the A1056 Killingworth Interchange, a distance of 2850 metres; or
  - (ii) southbound exit slip road at Killingworth Interchange.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
  - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
