ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (Hinton Cross, Worcestershire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012

Made 18th June 2012 Coming into force - -25th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, at Hinton Cross south of Evesham in the County of Worcestershire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Hinton Cross, Worcestershire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 25th June 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the first length of trunk road" means the A46 between a point 210 metres north and a

point 210 metres south of its junction with Broadway

Road, Hinton Cross;

"the second length of trunk road" means the A46 between a point 60 metres north and a

point 60 metres south of its junction with Broadway Road,

Hinton Cross:

"the works period" means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 2nd

July 2012 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.
- 4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on lengths of the

second length of trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that length of road are displayed.

- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- **6.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle-
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
 - (iii) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes.
