ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Toll Motorway (M6 Junction 11a – M6 Toll Junction 6) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 18th July 2012

 Coming into force
 25th July 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Toll Motorway ("the M6 Toll") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway and three of those connecting roads, in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Toll Motorway (M6 Junction 11a – M6 Toll Junction 6) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 25th July 2012.

2. In this Order -

"the motorway"	means the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll from its junction with the M6 at Junction 11a to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction T6;
"a slip road"	 means the slip road leading – i) to the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll at Junction T8; ii) to the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll at Junction T7;
	and iii) to the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll from Norton
	Canes Motorway Service Area;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Wednesday 1st August 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
