ROAD TRAFFIC

The A3(M) Motorway (Junctions 3 - 5, Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made	-	-	30th July 2012
Coming into force	-	-	18th August 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3(M) Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that motorway and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3(M) Motorway (Junctions 3 - 5, Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 18th August 2012.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the A3(M) Motorway near Havant in the County of Hampshire;

"the length of southbound carriageway" means the southbound carriageway of the motorway between the 'off' slip road at Junction 3 (B2150 – Hulbert Road) and the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A27 at Broad Marsh Interchange south of Junction 5 (A2030 – Havant Road);

"a slip road" means -

- (i) the road leading from the B2150 (Hulbert Road) to the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 3, or
- (ii) the road leading from Purbrook Way to the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 4;

"works" mean carriageway repairs and all associated work on the motorway; and

"a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 20th August 2012 or on any subsequent day until 17th February 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of southbound carriageway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (b) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (c) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (d) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (e) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
