**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A1(M) Motorway (Junctions 15 to 17) and The A1(M) Spur Motorway (Alconbury) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *30th July 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *6th August 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and the A1(M) Spur Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the City of Peterborough and the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junctions 15 to 17) and The A1(M) Spur Motorway (Alconbury) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 6th August 2012.

2. In this Order –

“a slip road” means the –

(a) A1(M) Motorway –

(i) southbound exit slip road at J15 Sawtry,

(ii) southbound exit and northbound entry slip roads at Junction 16 Stilton, and

(iii) southbound entry and northbound exit slip roads at the A605 Fletton Parkway Interchange Junction 17, and

(b) A1(M) Spur Motorway southbound exit slip road from, and entry slip road to, the B1043 Ermine Street Roundabout, Alconbury at Junction 14;

“works” mean safety fence tensioning and lighting column maintenance;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 13th August 2012 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.
